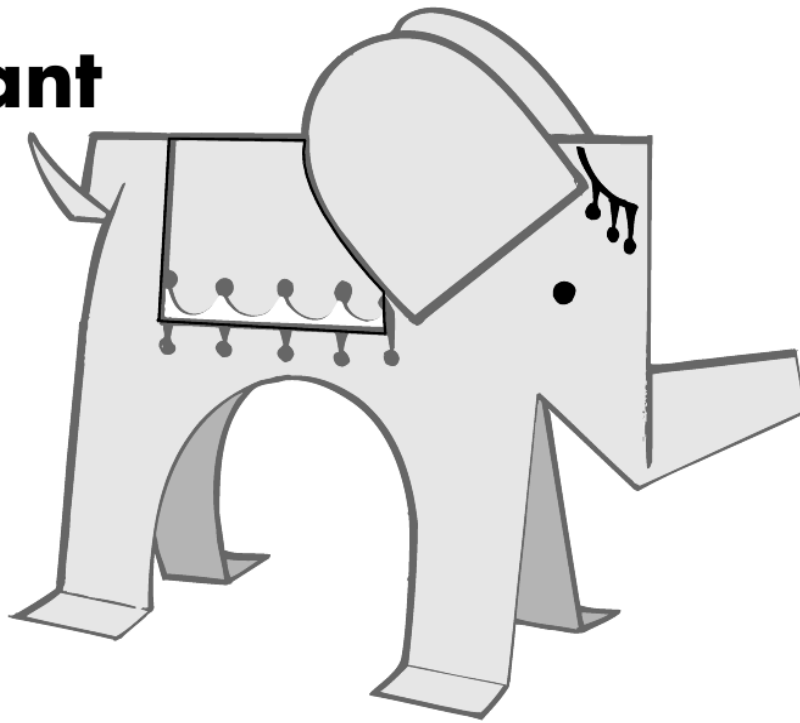


# Elephant

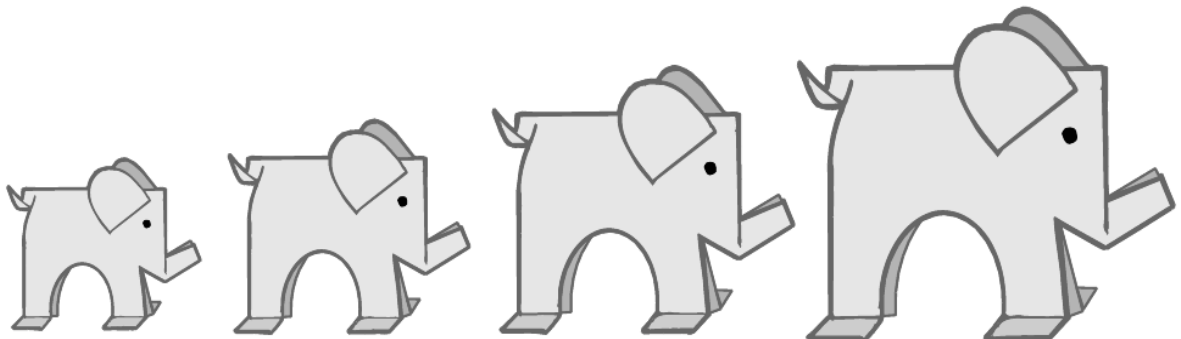


## Materials

- colorful paper rectangles—5.5" x 10" (14 x 25.5 cm)
- black marking pen
- scissors
- glue

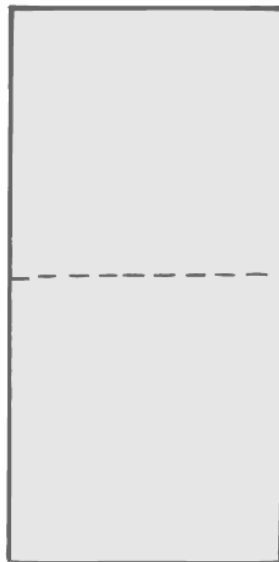
## Ways to Use

- Make the elephants in many sizes. Students can create a whole family of elephants to march across their desktops.
- Create a parade of circus elephants. Add a colorful blanket and headpiece using paper scraps and marking pens.
- Make a series of elephants to sit on top of a library shelf. Write the title of a good elephant story on each elephant to encourage students to try new books.

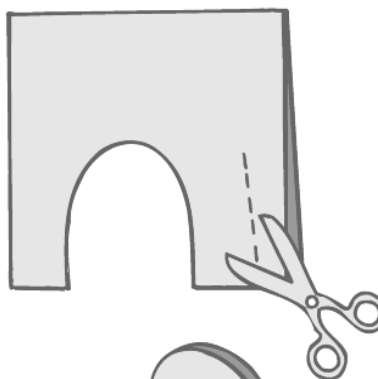


## Steps to Follow

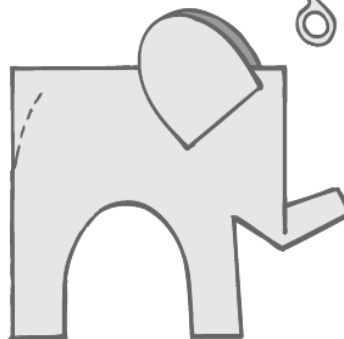
- 1 Fold the rectangle in half.



- 2 Cut a slanted line for the trunk.  
Cut out a rounded section for the legs.



- 3 Use the rounded scraps as ears.  
Fold up the trunk and glue it in place.  
Cut a tail.



- 4 Bend up the tail.  
Fold up sections for the feet.  
Add the eyes with the marking pen.
